Kansans received more than \$14.5 million in free and assisted programs from YMCAs.

Kansas YMCAs relieved the burden of government by providing \$2.5 million in front-line services through public grants, contracts and vouchers.

The Y is a charity of choice for the Kansans who donated \$13.3 million to the 10 YMCA associations, and an additional \$5.3 million worth of time to help all ages learn, grow and thrive.

1 in 5 Kansans Served

535,647 Kansans discovered healthy living through Y services and programs that address the obesity crisis in Kansas. 30.0% of Kansans are obese (19th highest in the nation).



1 in 4 Kansas Children Served

180,000 Kansas children achieved school readiness, academic success and healthy habits through Y services and programs. The Y is the largest provider of child and after school care in Kansas. Studies show that young children who develop healthy habits are more likely to be healthy adults.
